In 2004, a Colorado yoga teacher and beekeeper stumbled into a soapmaking class. It changed his entire concept of how a lather could hydrate his skin in the arid Rocky Mountain air.



In 2025, the beekeeper and his son will begin a modest production limited by their supply of backyard honey.



He tinkered tirelessly with combinations of natural base and essential oils. He sprinkled in flowers from the garden. He dribbled in honey spun from his four backyard beehives.



Hand-poured and hand-cut, the bars are truly a homemade product.


THE HONEY



The soap draws its distinctiveness from the honey, from the bees who draw upon the flowers. Soap Honey, in this sense, emerges uniquely from the flora of this particular beekeeper's garden.



The quality of the honey comes from the quality of the bees' diet. Accordingly, the beekeeper's garden is full of delectable flowers for bees: borage, bergamot, bee balms, hyssop, calendula, poppies, lemon balm, and peonies.



Accumulating no more than 50 litres of honey each year, the beekeeper also utilizes the honey, the wax, and the propolis to make tinctures and lip balms.

MADE TO ORDER

Natural essential oils are volatile. While Soap Honey remains lovely for years (kept in a dry place) - a bar is most fragrant in the season it was crafted. Like chefs serving dishes hot, all Soap Honey bars are made-to-order.



Week 1: Soap is cooked, poured, swirled with color, and hand-cut

Weeks 2-5: Soap is cured by drying. This ensures the soap is safe and gives a great lather


Week 6: Soap is boxed and shipped

To ensure soap is sent out fresh, Soap Honey has a 3-month production cycle. It distributes in four batches per year.

Orders are possible until one month before any batch. For instance, orders for the November batch end on October 1st.



All base oils and essential oils are natural, and many are also organic.

The soap coloring comes from nature-identical compounds like ultramarine and ferrous oxide. Customers can order soap with or without the colourful swirls.
